### French 1

Grades: 9-12

Dates: June 20th - July 29th Time: 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Early Registration Fee: \$650

This course focuses on the basic understanding, speaking, reading, and writing of the French language. This class gives students the opportunity to complete a full year of a UC approved French 1 course and earns 10 credits. A letter grade will be awarded.

### Spanish 1

Early Registration Fee: \$650

This course focuses on the basic understanding, speaking, reading, and writing of the Spanish language. This class gives students the opportunity to complete a full year of a UC approved Spanish 1 and earns 10 credits. A letter grade will be awarded.

### Le français dans le monde—French 3 Bridge

This is a non credit bearing class designed to assist students in passing the French challenge examination. Upon completion of the French challenge examination, students will be prepared to take AP French IV. This class is a non-credit bearing class. Prerequisite: French 2

### Drivers Education

Dates: June 20th - July 15th Time: 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Early Registration Fee: \$175

Completion of a California Drivers Ed course is required prior to obtaining your learner's permit, and ultimately receiving your Driver's License. Students will complete 40 hours of classroom instruction and receive a passing grade in order to complete the Driver's education course. This is a non-credit bearing class.

### Tennis for Everyone

### Musical Theatre Workshop

Students enrolled in the course will be given on-stage experience and will be expected to participate in the culminating performance. This course earns 5 credits as a general elective and a letter grade will be awarded.

### Music Appreciation (Hybrid)

Dates: June 20th—July 29 Time: 12:30 PM to 2:30 PM

Early Registration Fee: \$400

This class gives students the opportunity to complete a full year of a UC approved fine arts course and earns 10 credits. Students will spend 60 hours in class and 60 hours outside of class utilizing the CUSDMoodle server to complete class assignments, discussions, and tests. A letter grade will be awarded. \*

### Public Health and Safety (On-line)

Grades: 9-12

Dates: June 20th - July 29th

Early Registration Fee: \$95

Students will gain practical knowledge related to decisions that they must make concerning nutrition, human sexuality, hygiene, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and first aid. This course fulfills the high school public health and safety requirement and earns 5 credits. A Pass / Fail grade will be awarded. \*

### Computer Education (On-line)

Grades: 9-12

Dates: June 20th - July 29th

Early Registration Fee: \$95

Students will be introduced to graphics, word processing, electronic spreadsheet, data management and presentation software. This class fulfills the high school computer education requirement and earns 5 credits. A Pass / Fail grade will be awarded. \*

\* On-line and Hybrid courses are offered through CUSD's Moodle server and require computer and internet access. Students must have moodle access prior to June 1st. For on-line classes there is a required face-to-face final exam on July 28th or August 25th between 8am and 12 pm.
